The Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina recently held their 2009 Partner Appreciation Awards Luncheon in Charlotte. In October 2008, Second Harvest began providing backpacks for the Service League of Hickory to distribute bi-monthly to Longview and Southwest Elementary Schools. Because of their efforts, need-based qualified children in Catawba County are receiving food to take home for use on the weekends and holidays when school meals are not available.
